ENVIRONMENTAL TRANSFORMATION

Here in the most densely populated state in the nation, Veolia has funded more than 30 environmental projects over the past three years. We've partnered with organizations like SPLASH, a citizen science program that monitors the health of the Delaware River. Statewide, we've reforested parks, supported community gardens and coordinated numerous cleanups of communities and waterways in the region.
